

INTANZ'S PRIMARY AIM IS TO CONSISTENTLY PROMOTE RESPONSIBLE PRACTICES THROUGHOUT THE TANNING INDUSTRY

INTANZ Membership Code of Practice

SPIRIT

1. Members shall ensure their actions uphold the Associations' Code of Practice and their actions shall not detrimentally affect the perception of the industry.
2. Members should comply with all applicable laws, regulations and INTANZ rules.
3. The Code of Practice is subject to constant review to enable the development of high standards of practice.

HYGIENE

4. All equipment and accessories that are subject to body contact after each tanning session.
5. Members will be required to have protective eyewear and gloves available for staff use.

TECHNICAL

6. Controlled ultraviolet radiation emitting devices must be maintained and serviced to an approved standard, as detailed by the equipment supplier and in compliance with NZ appliance requirements.
7. A record of lamp operating hours should be recorded and kept on the premises &/or lamps are routinely checked for UVR output to ensure full sets of lamps are changed within specified useful life.
8. Be able to reference information from the bed manufacturer and have details on the premises including tanning table details.

OPERATING PRACTICES

9. All staff members who will be operating the sunbeds must be trained to the basic INTANZ standard as a minimum.
10. All staff members must understand the rudiments of skincare, skin typing and how the skin tans.
11. Members must have a sunbed/tanning protocol in place.
12. A copy of the Aus/NZ Solaria Standard 2635:2008 shall be kept on the premises.
13. Display information clearly regarding salon rules and risks of UV exposure.

CLIENT MANAGEMENT

14. All clients shall complete skin type assessment and provide client consent; these records to be kept on the premises.
15. Staff shall advise clients on their recommended exposure schedule.
16. Repeated exposure shall be administered no sooner than 48 hours after the previous exposure and not exceed 3 times per week.
17. Individuals with Skin Photo Type 1 shall not be allowed to use a tanning unit.
18. No person under the age of 18 shall use a sun-tanning unit without a written medical consent.
19. Provide protective eyewear for each client.
20. Clients on photosensitive medication should not have a sunbed session.
